More of less notable narcissistic Failures connoted by fragile Identity, affective-emotional weakness, avoid or loneliness feeling, anxiety, mood’s fluctuation, relative, bad control of emotion and of aggressivity, possible actings against himself, even violent acting reaching proof of its existence due to a fragile Identity; immature emotional development [31,33].

ii. Complex imaginary and possible odd fantasy, even with perverse connotations.

iii. Cahotic pulsional Organization.

iv. They could experiment a dependence on the other with a search for support, even promiscuity or “a contrario”, an intrusive perception of the other, possibly depending of the encounter [34].

Conclusion

As had been written notably by H. Akiska (1981, 1983) about a population sample, it seems that the emotional disorders are frequent by borderline subjects, such emotional disturbances as well as depressive feelings appears, as well as instinctual troubles, such anorexia, disruptive conduct, facilitated by addictive behavior, disruptive comportment, poor impulse control, leading to possible hetero-aggressive acts or especially self-aggression such as self-harm or mutilation or suicide.
